






## Driving Directions to Beorgwic from Sydney

Description	ODO	
<p>Follow the Sydney – Canberra freeway past the turn off to Marulan on the left.</p> <p>Start your odometer at the turn off.</p>	<p>Start Now</p>	
<p>Continue past the turn off to Marulan on the right</p>	<p>2.5 km</p>	
<p>Turn left at the sign towards Bungonia then immediately turn right onto Jerrara Rd towards Bungonia.</p>	<p>5 km</p>	
<p>At the T- intersection with Mountain Ash Rd turn left towards the towns of Windellama and Corang</p>	<p>24km</p>	
<p>Drive straight through the town of Bungonia. The road changes name to Oallen Ford Road</p>		
<p>Follow Oallen Ford Road for a long way.</p> <p>At the T- intersection with Nerriga Rd turn right towards Braidwood</p>	<p>75km</p>	

<p>Turn left at the sign saying MONGARLOWE. The road you are turning onto is CHARLEYS FOREST ROAD.</p>	<p>88km</p>	
<p>Follow CHARLEYS FOREST ROAD. Continue past the sign marked "ROSE GLEN". This sign is posted on both sides of a gate.</p>		
<p>Turn left onto the private road at the sign "ROSE VALLEY". This sign is posted on both sides of the gate that leads to the property.</p> <p>The gate is locked with code padlock (see instructions below).</p>	<p>94.5km</p>	
<p>Follow the private road for approximately 5 km to Beorgwic on Danelaw's property, called Dunghaven.</p> <p>Look out for the Beorgwic signs once on the private road.</p>	<p>99.5km</p>	

The front gate has a black code padlock on it (along with several normal metal ones). The code for the padlock will be sent to you after you register, please ensure that everyone you know is coming has the code and knows how to open the lock.

To open, turn the tumblers to the code, then squeeze the metal shank down into the black body of the lock, it will click then spring open. If it does not open check the tumblers are set on the code, give in a shake and pull, then try squeezing again.

The AAF has a mobile that works on site, if you have issues, please ring 0439 782 752. This phone will only be available on the weekend of Beorgwic, so please don't try and call it in the meantime. There is a public phone in Nerriga if you need it.
